

Application preparation and conditions

Teachers in Kimberley Catholic schools benefit from supportive working conditions including:

- ✓ Provided housing, or subsidised rent
- ✓ Electricity subsidies
- Relocation costs on appointment and conclusion of contract, including motor vehicles
- ✓ Travel provisions, including annual flights
- ✓ Location allowance
- Financial incentives for remote and isolated locations
